Vernon in early January.

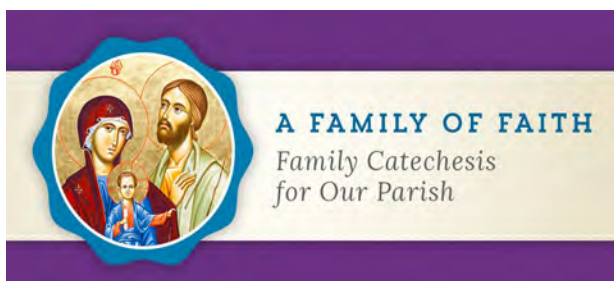

Dear St. Francis Xavier Parishioners,

After seven-plus months as a new Parish Family with St. Mary Anacortes and St. Paul Swinomish, we have continued to experience many changes. These have included new priests and pastor, new airplane contract to better serve Orcas and Lopez Islands, new communication methods, more consistent bilingual liturgies, and changes in the Daily Mass schedules for each island, to name a few. We've also been blessed by the surprise arrival of the evangelistic ministry of the MSP Brothers to our entire new Parish Family - who have recently doubled in size to a team of four! On Orcas and Lopez we've also welcomed the Mercy Sisters to the Parish Staff as Pastoral Coordinators and support staff to those isolated communities.

We are about to enter another phase of change. After a combined thirty+ years of service to parish and office administration, both Jan Steckler and Michele Gosinski shared with the Parish Family staff in the fall their intention to finish out their employment at the St. Francis Friday Harbor Office this coming summer, 2025.

We all want to thank Jan and Michele for all that they have done to help St. Francis Xavier parish literally navigate the San Juan Islands - and for Jan, under the leadership of over a dozen priests, including eight pastors, over twenty-five years.

I want to personally thank Jan for holding our parish together with Band-Aids, duct-tape and ferry schedules for most of the last 25+ years. It's not been that bad, but really, I did not fully appreciate the complexity of these island churches until I started navigating the ferries and communities myself.

Jan and I are both very grateful for the recent office arrival of Michele Gosinski during the pandemic, and her presence has brought new gifts to the parish office and parish programs.

After Jan and Michele retire from parish employment, they intend to continue to live out the lay ministry God has given them in many of the same volunteer faith formation and liturgical capacities they have long served, but not so much in the positions of leadership or coordination.

To fill the gap being left by these two great Christian women, we are announcing the job opening for one combined Parish Life Coordinator/Admin Asst for St. Francis Xavier, Friday Harbor. The details of this preferred bilingual position will be posted on the Archdiocesan and St. Francis Xavier Parish websites as soon as possible. A hiring committee will be brought together from both Anacortes and Friday Harbor communities to field qualified bilingual candidates.

The exact timing of the Office transition in Friday Harbor will depend on a variety of factors, including the length of the hiring and interview process and the wrapping up of the Faith Formation programs this coming Easter Season.

In the meantime, please join me in thanking Jan and Michele for their many years of service to our Church and please keep our outgoing and our incoming staff in your prayers in the days and months to come.

Queridos feligreses de St. Francisco Xavier:

Después de más de siete meses como nueva familia parroquial con Sta. Maria Anacortes y San Pablo Swinomish, hemos seguido experimentando muchos cambios. Estos han incluido nuevos sacerdotes y pastor, un nuevo contrato de avión para servir mejor a las islas Orcas y López, nuevos métodos de comunicación, liturgias bilingües más consistentes y cambios en los horarios de las misas diarias para cada isla. También hemos sido bendecidos por la llegada sorpresa del ministerio evangelístico de los hermanos, Misioneros Servidores de la Palabra, a toda nuestra nueva familia parroquial, ¡que recientemente han duplicado su tamaño a un equipo de cuatro! En Orcas y López, también, hemos dado la bienvenida a las Hermanas de la Misericordia al personal parroquial como coordinadoras pastorales y personal de apoyo para esas comunidades aisladas.

Estamos a punto de entrar en otra fase de cambio. Después de más de treinta años combinados de servicio en la administración de la parroquia y la oficina, tanto Jan Steckler como Michele Gosinski han compartido con el personal de la Familia Parroquial. En el otoño, van a terminar su empleo en la Oficina de St. Francisco Xavier, Friday Harbor este próximo verano de 2025.

Todos queremos agradecer a Jan y Michele por todo lo que han hecho para ayudar a la parroquia de St. Francisco Xavier a navegar literalmente por las Islas de San Juan, y por Jan, bajo el liderazgo de más de una docena de sacerdotes, incluidos ocho párrocos, durante veinticinco años.

Quiero agradecer personalmente a Jan por mantener unida a nuestra parroquia con curitas, cinta adhesiva y horarios de ferry durante la mayor parte de los últimos veinticinco años. No ha sido tan malo, pero realmente, no aprecié completamente la complejidad de estas iglesias de la isla hasta que comencé a navegar por los ferrys y las comunidades yo mismo.

Jan y yo estamos muy agradecidos por la reciente llegada a la oficina de Michele Gosinski durante la pandemia, y su presencia ha traído nuevos dones a la oficina parroquial y los programas parroquiales.

Después de que Jan y Michele se jubilen de su empleo en la parroquia, tienen la intención de seguir apoyando el ministerio laico que Dios les ha dado en muchas de las mismas capacidades litúrgicas y de formación de la fe voluntarias que han desempeñado durante mucho tiempo, pero no tanto en los puestos de liderazgo o coordinación.

Para llenar el vacío que dejan estas dos grandes mujeres cristianas, estamos anunciando la vacante de un Coordinador Pastoral - Gerente de Oficina combinado para St. Francis Xavier, Friday Harbor. Los detalles de este puesto bilingüe se publicarán en los sitios web de la Arquidiócesis y de la Parroquia St. Francis Xavier lo antes posible. Se reunirá un comité de contratación de las comunidades de Anacortes y Friday Harbor para presentar candidatos bilingües calificados.

El momento exacto de la transición de la Oficina en Friday Harbor dependerá de una variedad de factores, incluida la duración del proceso de contratación y entrevistas y la finalización de los programas de Formación de la Fe en la próxima temporada de Pascua.

Mientras tanto, únanse a mí para agradecer a Jan y Michele por sus muchos años de servicio a nuestra Iglesia y tengan en sus oraciones a nuestro personal saliente y entrante en los próximos días y meses.
