How can I practice good stewardship at Blessed Sacrament?

As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another as good stewards of God's varied grace. - 1 Peter 4:10

Stewardship is ...

... a way of life, achieved through conversion of heart and mind, in which we recognize that all we have is a gift from our generous God, meant to be shared with others. It is typically lived out in terms of our time, talent, and treasure.

Time (Praying)

Before we can sincerely return a proportionate amount of our talents and financial resources to God, we must first give Him all of our heart. Recognizing that true stewardship flows from each individual's personal relationship with the Lord, we know that any important relationship must be actively tended if it is to grow stronger. We invite you to explore daily Mass, weekly Adoration, and the prayer groups we offer at Blessed Sacrament.

Talent (Serving)

Ministry in parishes thrives, in large part, because of the countless talents shared by members of the faith community. Without the hands and hearts of parishioners, parish functions would be unable to continue. Check out the many ministries at Blessed Sacrament to see where your talents can best serve our community—we have everything from event planning and coordination to local outreach to Bible and book studies. We also have life-stage-based groups such as those for young adults, moms, or men.

Treasure (Giving)

Through prayer, each person can determine how to proportionately support the parish in a financial manner in a responsible way. Are you giving nothing right now? Maybe next week, start giving 1% of your yearly wages or 1 hour's wages. In 6 months, bump that up to 2% and so on. The percentages and timing are between you and God. But He is pleased when His children take any step of faith toward Him, so don't let imperfection stop your progress. Get moving, and you'll build the muscles needed for a lifetime of generous giving. Keeping Blessed Sacrament open for the past 100 years has only been possible because of the parishioners before us. Please support the work at Blessed Sacrament, however large or small, so that we can continue to spread God's Word for the next 100 years.

Welcome to Blessed Sacrament! My name is Steve Castrogiovanni, and I am the principal of Blessed Sacrament School. I wanted to take a few moments to welcome you and tell you a little about our school.

We opened our doors over 100 years ago in the fall of 1924. Then, as now, BSS offers a Christ-centered education based upon the Dominican Pillars of Prayer, Study, Community, and Ministry. In summer 2024, the Schoenstatt Fathers became the administrators of Blessed Sacrament Parish and School. We serve children in 3-year-old preschool through 8th grade. Our multi-age classroom model allows us to meet each student where they are and challenge them academically based on their individual needs. In addition to our standard 3K and 4K programs, we offer a Montessori Children's House for children ages 3-5.

We view each student in our school as a gift from God. Our highly qualified teachers offer not only exemplary academics but also foster a sense of community by teaching and modeling the virtues of compassion, justice, peace, and personal responsibility.

Families play an important role at Blessed Sacrament School. Parents are invited to partner with us to create a loving, caring atmosphere where children may develop intellectually, emotionally, physically, and spiritually to their greatest potential.
