Dominic Deliberations

T he month of June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus where we honor the Love of Jesus Christ shown us through His heart being exposed to us. His heart radiates light, it is enflamed with love and it is crowned by two images of His passion: the Cross and Crown of Thorns. He told us that He loves us, "No greater love has a man than to lay down his life for his friends." He also backed up his words with actions by quietly and humbly going to the cross to die for us; suffering excruciating pain out of love for us. I would invite you to pray the Litany of the Sacred Heart on Fridays in June and if you are feeling really motivated; to attend nine consecutive first Fridays dedicating them to the Sacred Heart. Another devotion is to enshrine the Sacred and Immaculate Hearts of Mary in your home and dedicating your family to them; making the Sacred and Immaculate Hearts the center of your home. The Feast of Corpus Christi is celebrated on June 22nd which is the weekend of Fr. Peter's and Fr. Bernie's retirement parties. St. Mary's will be having a Eucharistic Procession that everyone is invited to participate in, it will begin immediately after the 8 a.m. Mass on Thursday, June 19th .

We celebrate having four men ordained to the priesthood for the Diocese of Madison this past Friday. We have men entering the priesthood as we are experiencing in a very concrete way the loss of two priests retiring and being replaced by only one; Fr. Joseph Bellamkonda. This is a good reminder to daily pray that God will call good men to answer the call to the priesthood and good women to answer the call to consecrated religious life. Many have been wondering about changes that will occur after Fr. Bernie Rott and Fr. Peter Auer retire.

Fr. Joseph Bellamkonda will be living at the rectory in Hazel Green when he arrives July 1st. The Masses in the pastorate will be split between myself, Fr. Tom Kelley, and Fr. Joseph with periodic help out from Fr. Dave Flangan as retired priest living in residence at St. Rose. Fr. Eric Nielsen is serving St. Augustine's at UW Platteville and will live at the rectory in Platteville and may help out periodically if needed and his time allows. We are blessed to have three active priests along with a retired priest assisting us.

The Sunday Mass schedule will not change because it was established to accommodate three active priests. The Weekday Mass schedule will change. There are no Masses on Mondays. Tuesday Mass will be held in Platteville and Kieler. Wednesday Mass will be held at Dickeyville and Cuba City. Thursday Mass will be held at Platteville, Kieler, Hazel Green, Cuba City, and every other week in Benton; please note that Mass time in Hazel Green is being changed to 8:30. Friday Mass will be held at Sinsinawa, Cuba City, and Park Place. Saturday morning Mass will be held at St. Mary's. All Mass times will stay the same with the exception of Hazel Green's Mass on Thursday being at 8:30 a.m.

Catholic Corner

Reflection: Today, we celebrate the most glorious Solemnity of Pentecost, the promised Gift of the Father and the Son to Jesus' disciples. After rising from the dead, Jesus appeared to His disciples for forty days. During those appearances, He offered them proof of His resurrection, continued to teach them, and reminded them of all He had revealed to them about His death and Resurrection, preparing them for the next step of their mission. "While meeting with them, he enjoined them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for 'the promise of the Father about which you have heard me speak; for John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the holy Spirit" (Acts 1:4–5).

During the ten days after Jesus' Ascension, the eleven Apostles gathered together in the upper room—most likely the place where they ate the first Eucharist—with Jesus' mother and many other disciples, totaling 120. As they met, they cast lots and chose Matthias as ludas' successor.

On the fiftieth day after Jesus' Resurrection, ten days after His Ascension, the 120 disciples were again gathered in the upper room when they experienced something beyond their imagination. From the sky, a noise like a strong driving wind filled the room. Tongues, as of fire, fell upon all gathered, and by the power of the Holy Spirit, they were given the gift of tongues, which enabled them to speak in different languages to the diverse groups of people in Jerusalem.

The Holy Spirit also sanctifies every individual believer, especially through the Seven Gifts of the Holy Spirit. According to the *Catechism* of the Catholic Church, "The seven gifts of the Holy Spirit are wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety, and fear of the Lord... They complete and perfect the virtues of those who receive them.

Luke Voegeli




Ellie Riddle
