Dominic Deliberations

"Let us come before His presence with thanksgiving" Ps. 95:2

We celebrate The Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus Christ present in the Eucharist this weekend, and in this, we thank God for remaining with us in the Eucharist. I would encourage all of us to make a concerted effort to participate in Eucharistic Adoration when it's provided in the pastorate because we have much for which we should be grateful. Most importantly God's presence and work of salvation that is accomplished at every Mass. Secondly, as we celebrate the retirements of Fr. Peter Auer and Fr. Bernie Rott, we need to thank God for their, yes to the priesthood, their many years of service to the Church, and the many ways that they are Jesus Christ for us. Eucharistic Adoration can help us grow in virtue and overcome sinful habits as Jesus sheds out the light of His grace upon us and we receive it by contemplating His immense goodness. Thanksgiving also draws us out of the heaviness that comes from ingratitude, anger, negative thoughts and speech. It has been said that doing Eucharistic Adoration is like spiritually basking in the Son.

The Eucharist cannot exist without a validly ordained priest celebrating the liturgical rite entrusted to him by the Church. This is one of many reasons why there is so much joy among the faithful when ordinations take place. As he celebrates the liturgical rite, he is celebrating the one Holy and unbloodied sacrifice of Jesus' crucifixion for us. Jesus' crucifixion is our justification because by it, He has redeemed us from our sins. As the priests were chosen in the Old Testament to offer sacrifices in the temple on behalf of the people, so to today, does the priest offer to God both a sin offering and a sacrifice of thanksgiving along with and on behalf of the faithful. We have been redeemed by the precious blood of Jesus Christ. (1 Pt. 1:19). The Church is formed from the side of Jesus Christ and His priestly sacrifice. It is said, "if there is no priest, there is no Eucharist, and if there is no Eucharist, there is no Church." Today we highlight the Eucharist in this celebration but to truly appreciate it, we also have to appreciate all that Jesus instituted when He instituted it.

End of the Church's fiscal year. The church ends its fiscal year in June. This time of year can be challenging because the weekly collection and donations drop due to people traveling and fewer activities happening with school being out. I would ask for your help in concluding the fiscal year strong with donations. As inflation has gone up, I ask you to consider increasing your giving this next year to match inflation. Thank you for your generosity and support of the parish with your time, talent, and treasure.

Catholic Corner

When the time arrived for Elizabeth to have her child she gave birth to a son. Her neighbors and relatives heard that the Lord had shown his great mercy toward her, and they rejoiced with her. When they came on the eighth day to circumcise the child, they were going to call him Zechariah after his father, but his mother said in reply, "No. He will be called John." But they answered her, "There is no one among your relatives who has this name." So they made signs, asking his father what he wished him to be called. He asked for a tablet and wrote, "John is his name," and all were amazed. Immediately

his mouth was opened, his tongue freed, and he spoke blessing God. ~Luke 1:57-64 When Elizabeth conceived John the Baptist, she and her husband, Zechariah, "were advanced in years" (Luke 1:7). The angel Gabriel announced the child's birth to Zechariah when his priestly clan chose him by lot to enter the Temple sanctuary to burn incense to the Lord. Zechariah was told that his wife would conceive and bear a son who would "be great in the sight of the Lord...be filled with the Holy Spirit even from his mother's womb... turn many of the children of Israel to the Lord...will go before him in the spirit and power of Elijah...turn the hearts of fathers toward children...to prepare a people fit for the Lord" (Luke 1:15–17). The announcement was joyous beyond belief. After the sorrow of having no children, Zechariah would have a child "great in the sight of the Lord." Disbelieving the angel, Zechariah was struck mute until John was born.

That same Archangel, Gabriel, appeared to Mary to announce that she would conceive the Savior of the World by the overshadowing of the Holy Spirit. Gabriel

then told her, "And behold, Elizabeth, your relative, has also conceived a son in her old age, and this is the sixth month for her who was called barren; for nothing will be impossible for God" (Luke 1:36–37). In the Father's plan of salvation, John's mission was intimately connected to that of Jesus.

John's birth was surrounded by mystery, amazement, awe, and intrigue. St. Luke records the reaction to his birth as, "Then fear came upon all their neighbors, and all these matters were discussed throughout the hill country of Judea. All who heard these things took them to heart, saying, 'What, then, will this child be?' For surely the hand of the Lord was with him" (Luke 1:65–66).

Other than the Solemnity of the Birth of Christ (Christmas), the Church honors only Saint John with a solemnity on his birth. While our Blessed Mother's Immaculate Conception is commemorated with a solemnity, her birth is celebrated with a feast. It is a great honor, indeed, to honor this unique man's birth with the highest rank of celebration within our Church.

Saint John the Baptist, Through your conception and birth, God spoke to the world that He can do anything He so chooses and bring forth His saving grace whenever He wills. Please pray that I will more fully understand the role you played in salvation history and be more open to all that God has revealed to the world through your holy life. Saint John the Baptist, pray for me. Jesus, I trust in You.
