Sunday's Readings Reflection

God's Law is within Reach: Deuteronomy 30:10-14, highlighted in Veritatis Splendor, suggests that God's moral law is not an external, imposed burden, but rather something inscribed within human nature, in the heart and mind.

Freedom and Truth: Veritatis Splendor underscores the connection between human freedom and truth. It argues that genuine freedom lies in conforming to the truth, which includes God's moral law. Ignoring this connection leads to the detachment of freedom from truth, which is a dangerous error.

Relevance for Today: The passage from Deuteronomy, as presented in the encyclical, serves as a reminder that God's moral precepts are not impossible to follow. It encourages individuals to embrace and live according to these precepts, which are necessary for true human flourishing.




