

Dominic Deliberations

 ${\cal J}$ esus gives to us, in this weekend's gospel, the treasure of prayer in teaching the disciples the "Our Father". In the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults, there is a formal giving the gift of prayer to those joining the Church by giving them the "Our Father".

"We must humble ourselves before God as our Father; without his creative activity this thing that prays would have no being. And yet, in creating us, he allowed something of himself to pass into us; he is our Father in that sense too... as an earthly father does not merely give life to his children once for all, but continues to maintain life in them by supplying their daily needs, so the God who created us keeps us from moment to moment, showers down upon us, in the natural or in the supernatural order, the gifts by which we maintain ourselves in the order of his creation, the gifts by which we live. Is that all fatherhood means? Why, no; fatherhood gives authority, demands the exercise of authority if it is to be fatherhood in the true sense. While the son's character is yet too wayward and inexperienced to let him choose for himself, decide for himself, the father must choose for him, decide for him; enforce those decisions, if necessary, by the use of correction. What son is there, whom the father does not chasten? So God, infinitely wiser, dictates our choice to us, recalls us by means of punishments if we set up our wills in obstinate resistance to his." *The Pastoral Sermons, Ronald Knox pgs. 3-4*

Knox continues by saying while the Lord's teaching of the Father's authority and correction is mentioned less than his clemency, it is none the less an important aspect of which we shy away from.

God the Father is our true father, any true experience of fatherhood is a share in the full fatherhood of God the Father. It is to him that all other fathers must look to see the model that they are to imitate. In a culture where authority is seen as oppressive, dangerous, and abusive; fathers struggle to lead their children and family with confidence as a person with true authority. Authority carried with humility, rooted in what is true and morally upright shouldn't be feared but embraced. Keeping the family together and protecting the family from being pulled apart by various activities requires saying NO. It is in this 'no' that the family experiences that a father is saying 'yes' to them. God our Father says no but it's because he's saying yes to and for us.

Catholic Corner

"And I tell you, ask and you will receive; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you." Luke 11:9

If we were to take this statement of Jesus in a very literal way we could easily conclude that Jesus will give us anything we ask for in a prayerful way. But we know this is not what happens. Perhaps everyone has prayed hard for this or that and the request was not answered in the way we wanted. Why is that? Did we simply fail to pray with faith? Will Jesus do whatever we ask of Him when we pray for it with all our might? Certainly not.

This passage goes on to say, "If you then, who are wicked, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will the Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him?" (Luke 11:13). Within this context, and within the context of everything that Jesus has taught us, it's important to know that there is one thing and one thing only for which we ought to pray. And when we pray for this one thing, we can be assured of obtaining it when we pray for it in faith. What is that one thing? It's the will of God.

If we sincerely and wholeheartedly ask for and seek the will of God, we can be certain that our Lord will give us the Holy Spirit and that the Holy Spirit will, in turn, lead us into the will of God for our lives. The problem is that too often we end up praying that "MY will be done" rather than "THY will be done." This is an important difference.

True prayer is ultimately about trust and surrender to God. We trust in His perfect plan and surrender to that perfect plan in our lives. When we do this, we can be assured that the Lord will hear and answer this perfect prayer.

Reflect, today, upon that simple prayer in the Lord's Prayer: *Thy will be done!* Strive to trust in God's perfect plan for your life and do all you can to surrender to it. With this form of prayer we can be assured that the Holy Spirit will come to us, leading us into His holy will.

Our Father who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done on earth, as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us, and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Jesus, I trust in You.


