

Thank you to those that planned and helped with the St. Dominic Feast Day Party and the Mazzuchelli Pilgrimage. Both are annual events that help build community and devotion to local Patrons of the pastorate. Please consider putting these events on your calendar for next year for early August.

The Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary celebrates that she was taken up body and soul into heavenly glory, and exalted by the Lord as Queen over all things, so that she might be the more fully conformed to her Son, the Lord of lords and conqueror of sin and death. Luke's Gospel says, "All generations will call me blessed": "The Church's devotion to the Blessed Virgin is intrinsic to Christian worship." The Church rightly honors "the Blessed Virgin with special devotion. From the most ancient times the Blessed Virgin has been honored with the title of 'Mother of God,' to whose protection the faithful fly in all their dangers and needs. . . . This very special devotion . . . differs essentially from the adoration which is given to the incarnate Word and equally to the Father and the Holy Spirit, and greatly fosters this adoration." The liturgical feasts dedicated to the Mother of God and Marian prayer, such as the rosary, an "epitome of the whole Gospel," express this devotion to the Virgin Mary. (CCC 971)

I would encourage all friend groups that gather regularly for fellowship to include the rosary at the beginning or end of the gathering, unless there is a different spiritual/faith component built into it. Mother Mary beautifully guides us to her Son if we faithfully devote ourselves to her.

A protestant doctor was performing a surgery on a person; during the surgery, she had a strong sense that she should entrust the patient to Jesus' Mother. She felt Mary's presence in the room guiding the surgery. She found out later that the family had been praying the rosary in the waiting room nonstop for the length of the surgery. Between this experience, a couple other profound experiences, and the witness of devout Catholics, she decided to join the Catholic Church a year ago. God bless,

Catholic Corner

August 15: Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary—Solemnity

Within Church history, one fascinating and inspiring phenomenon is the incorruptibility of some saints' bodies. In the course of history, when certain saints' bodies (e.g., Clare of Assisi, John Vianney, and Padre Pio) have been exhumed, the bodies have been found to be incorrupt, meaning they have not decayed. The Blessed Virgin's body, however, is unique. Not just incorrupt, it is alive, resurrected, transformed, and shares in eternal glory. Other than her Divine Son, the Mother of God is the only one to have been granted this privilege.

Today's Solemnity has been referred to variably as the Blessed Virgin Mary's rest, birth into Heaven, entombment, and falling asleep. The earliest written references to Mary's Assumption date back to the third and fourth centuries. In the seventh century, Saint John Damascene wrote beautifully about Mary's Assumption in three sermons. He relates a tradition that Mary died in the presence of the Apostles, but that when her tomb was opened at St. Thomas' request, it was found empty

Today, just outside Jerusalem, next to the Garden of Gethsemane, pilgrims can find an ancient church, believed to have been the Blessed Virgin's burial site, from which she rose and was assumed into Heaven. Like Christ her Son, her tomb is empty.

The ancient belief in the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary was elevated to the level of a dogma in 1950. As a dogma, the Church proclaimed that all the Catholic faithful must hold this belief as true and divinely revealed. It did not begin to be true in 1950; rather, that which had always been true was given great solemnity and clarity within Church teaching. The one deposit of faith—the truths in the mind of God revealed to us in Christ Jesus—does not change. Truth doesn't change; rather, our comprehension of the Truth deepens over time.

Dearest Mother, assumed into Heaven, you are the Immaculate Conception, the Ever-Virgin Mary, the Mother of God. As we honor your glorious Assumption, please pray for me and for all your children. In Heaven, your Son honors you, and your prayers are most effective. I entrust myself, my family, our Church, and the entire world to your motherly care and intercession. 




