There is a new grant opportunity from the Michigan Department of Education to provide funding to improve the health, safety, and wellness of learners. Non-public schools are eligible to apply and the award for our school could be approximately \$10,000 for mental Health and \$10,000 for Safety and Security. **Community input is necessary in the application process**. Please respond to this email by sharing ideas for initiatives, programs or materials that you feel would benefit our students.

Some of my thoughts for the **Safety and Security** portion of the grant, would be to upgrade our door locks so they can be opened with badges for getting around quicker. For the **Mental Health** portion of the grant, counseling or psychological services could be contracted using these funds. However, any other ideas or innovative initiatives will be considered and discussed at the next school commission meeting. Thank you!!
