While we understand that not all students can be in attendance every day until 5:00 PM, we will need to have enough students registered to ensure our numbers are steady throughout the duration of the grant. Our license allows up to 54 students to be in attendance daily but no less than 15 to receive the grant money.

We are blessed with this great opportunity for funding and the entire staff is very excited to help provide creative and educational options after school hours for the students! God bless!
