Last but certainly not least, A at St. Mary's School!

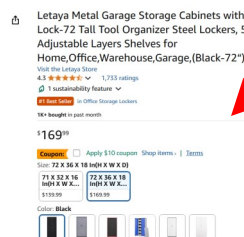
