Blessed Sacrament Strings 2025-2026

The Blessed Sacrament Strings Program gives students the opportunity to learn to play a string instrument and to share that gift with others.

The Blessed Sacrament Strings Program is open to students of any age. Students will have a variety of lessons (individual, small group, ensemble) based on experience, interest, age and ability. Performance opportunities will be arranged as appropriate to the developmental level of each student. Playing for Mass, public performances or service type projects are some of the possibilities. Students will learn music theory as they learn to play an instrument. Lessons will be held weekly as pullouts from the classroom. The time and length of each lesson will be determined in consultation with the classroom teacher and input from the parents. Every effort will be made to not pull students out of core subjects or special events.

Students may choose to play violin, viola, cello or bass. Students will be measured for instrument size during the first week of school and actual lessons will start after Labor Day.

Lessons will be prepaid on a determined schedule. The options are as follows.
