## Feast of St. Rocco



ST. ROCCO WAS BORN IN MONTPELIER IN FRANCE IN 1295. HIS PARENTS, JOHN AND LIBERIA, WERE WEALTHY AND VERY DEVOUT CHRISTIANS. WHEN HE WAS 20 YEARS OLD HE LOST HIS PARENTS. HE SOLD HIS PROPERTY FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE POOR AND DECIDED TO GO ON A PILGRIMAGE TO ROME. WHEN HE REACH PIACENZA IN NORTHERN ITALY HE TOOK CARE OF THE VICTIMS OF THE PLAGUE. EVENTUALLY HE HIMSELF WAS INFECTED WITH THE PESTILENCE. BY DIVINE INTERVENTION A DOG BROUGHT HIM A PIECE OF BREAD DAILY. ONE DAY THE OWNER OF THE DOG FOLLOWED HIS PET AND SAW THE PLAGUE STRICKEN ST. ROCCO AND NURSED HIM BACK TO HEALTH. ONCE HEALED, ST ROCCO CONTINUED TO TAKE CARE OF THE PLAGUE VICTIMS. LATER ON, HE RETURNED HOME AND BECAUSE OF THE REGIONAL WAR HE WAS SUSPECTED OF BEING A SPY. HE WAS PUT IN PRISON AND THERE HE LANGUISHED AND DIED OF HUNGER AND WANT. ONLY WHEN HIS RELATIVES WERE GETTING READY TO BURY HIM DID THEY NOTICE THE BIRTHMARK OF A CROSS ON HIS CHEST. AFTER HIS DEATH ON AUGUST 16, 1327, HIS DEVOTION SPREAD TO ITALY, FRANCE, GERMANY, ENGLAND, SPAIN AND THE PHILIPPINES.


## Edith Stein: The Seventh Chamber
