





A CHAIR HAS A FEAST DAY? SATURDAY 2.22 IS THE FEAST OF THE CHAIR OF ST. PETER

The relic of the chair of St. Peter has both a physical and authoritative spiritual significance.

Physical significance. "The relic is an ancient, ornamented chair located in the apse of St. Peter's Basilica. The object contains an ancient pre-fourth century chair that has been modified over time, most notably by the the famous Italian artist/architect Bernini (1598-1680).

Authoritative spiritual significance: From a homily by Fr. Michael DePalma

The "Chair" of St. Peter is not simply a piece of furniture; it is a statement of faith that Our Lord Jesus gave an authority to Saint Peter in regards to the Church that endures to this day in the mission and ministry of the pope as Bishop of Rome. The mission and ministry of the pope is not simply to rule as an earthly king over the Vatican or to be some kind of chairman of the board of the global Catholic Church. His authority is not just that of an executive who can dispense with this or that rule or practice any time he wants. The mission, ministry, authority and power of the pope as successor of St. Peter is simply this: he is the one who knows who Christ is.
