After some discussion, it was decided to no longer take up this collection rather than try to open this fundraiser to the parish since it would be brand new to the parish at large and would require extensive educational advertising. The St. Agatha Altar Society still has a thriving ministry which is already open to parish involvement, our Mother's Day collection for mothers and babies in needed.

NEW BUSINESS

Fundraiser Ideas – last month, we brainstormed spring fundraiser ideas. This month, we discussed them further.

- Rummage Sale of donations on hand
 - o This is still an option, but we need someone who knows how to sell on eBay to teach us how.
 - The President advertised our need in the school newsletter and through the monthly A.S. newsletter.
- Catholic Book Sale of supplies on hand
 - This would compete with the school book sale.
 - The Catholic books on hand are used, which would not garner enough participation for the effort.
- No Bake Bake Sale
 - The A.S. used to have an annual no bake bake sale. It is an option we might use if funds dip too low.

- Bingo requires too much work and would be in competition with parish activities.
- Catholic Movie Night requires too much work and would be in competition with parish activities.
- Read-a-thon would not garner enough interest to warrant the work involved.

Mother's Day fundraiser for Road 2 Hope to support new mothers and their children in need.

- Sarah let us know of a new Catholic charity, St. Maria's Home, that also supports new moms/babies and is based upon and guided by Road 2 Hope.
- The vote was unanimous to support <u>About Us St. Maria's Home</u> this year. President Barbara will ask Sarah if she could create a flyer. The collection will be financial only since St. Maria's Home does not have a site yet; they are currently collecting funds to build.
