






This food drive benefits our own St. Vincent de Paul food pantry.

The Four Last Things: Catholic Teaching on the Afterlife

Facilitators: Deacon Mark Henson & Deacon Paul Williams

What happens when you leave this material world and enter into the spiritual afterlife? What should you know about what your life will be like, on the other side of death? What are the four "last things" that will concern you, when you cross the threshold into eternal life?

Traditionally, the Catholic Church has defined the "last things" as four: **Death, Judgement, Heaven and Hell**. However, in this Catholic bible study, we will be focusing not only on these "last four things," but we will be expanding our list to include eight last things of concern for all of humanity: From the Moment of Death to Judgment, Purgatory to Heaven, Hell, to the General Resurrection of the Dead, to the Final Judgement and to the New Creation of Heaven and Earth at the End of Time.

This is 8-week Bible Study about "The Four Last Things: Catholic Teaching on the Afterlife", has been adapted from Agape Bible Study series entitled "The Eight Last Things." Sessions are on following Fridays from 6:30pm-8:30pm (Potluck Dinner in Parish Hall): April 25, May 2, May 9, May 16, May 30, June 6, June 13, June 27.

The study session will include: an opening prayer, a short introduction to the lesson, a PowerPoint presentation for the lesson, group discussions and a closing prayer. Please make sure you bring your Bible, a pen and some paper to write on. Please scan the QR Code or visit the parish website to REGISTER. The cost of the Bible Study is \$25 (includes a tote bag, pen and program folder).
