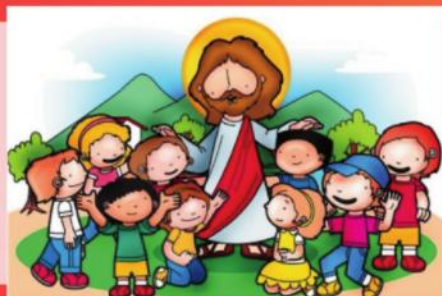

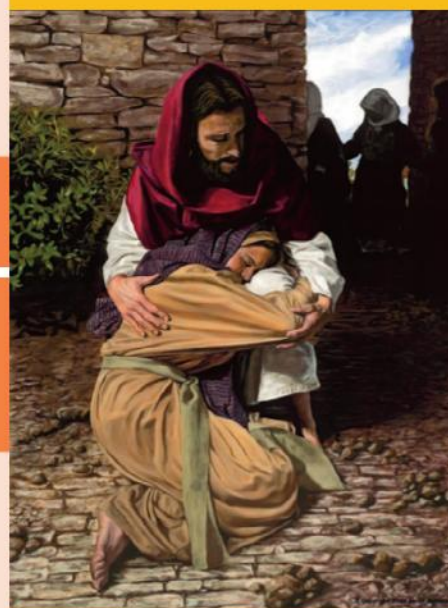

"Everyone of you who does not renounce all his possessions cannot be my disciple." LUKE 14:33
