NOTABLE ADJUSTMENTS: To better serve our young families, our faith formation team has discerned that some simple changes would benefit the children- please note a couple of adjustments:

2025-2026 "Young Disciples" program- our preschool through 5th grade:

- 1. The children will meet weekly from **6pm-7pm**
- 2. The **1**st **grade children** will have a separate class- they will not be in the atrium this year. This year will be focused on prayer, Bible Stories, and preparation for the sacraments in 2nd grade.
- 3. CGS will have more room for our youngest students- ages 3, 4, and 5!

As always, we look forward to meeting our 'Young Disciples' and helping them to grow in their love for the Lord! All are welcome!

<u>2025-2026 LifeTeen</u>: Our 6-12th graders will experience an opportunity for growing and nurturing personal relationships with the Lord through small group discussion, talks, Adoration, Confession opportunities, praise & worship, prayer opportunities and more! Our 6-8th graders and 9-11th graders will be separated for most talks and have their own spaces to meet. Our priests will be joining us as often as they are able and we have a great team of adults ready to share the faith with this group! We will meet every other week throughout the year. *Note: make sure to look at the schedule as we have 2 back-to-back meetings-1 per session*.

Youth Ministry Events: Throughout the year, there will be opportunities for both the 6-8th graders as well as the 9-12th graders. These will be promoted through LifeTeen, Flocknote, and in the bulletin- all kids are welcome to join in! These events help strengthen relationships with Jesus as well as build the greater Catholic community! Watch for more details! +++Fundraising to offset these events will be offered.
