

- The Religious Education Calendar HAS BEEN MAILED with confirmation of the day and time that we are expecting your child for the upcoming Faith Sharing Year. Families with children that have not yet registered will receive a calendar, however, registration is necessary for class placement for the fall. Forms can be downloaded from our website. Registrations must be received prior to the start of classes!
- We can't do it without you! WE NEED YOU! We need a minimum of 60 catechists/teachers as well as substitutes, general aides and helpers before we are able to welcome our nearly 500 young people back for a new year of Faith Sharing. Our Gospel passage, from Matthew, leads us to take a serious look at whether our lives give God the glory He deserves. It comes in the form of a question that Jesus poses to the disciples. He leads up to it gently enough: "Who do people say that the Son of Man is?" And they offer varying responses. Then, Jesus gets personal with them. "But who do you say that I am?" Peter gets the answer right: "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God."

Jesus is getting personal with us today. He poses the same question to each one of us who call ourselves His stewards and modern-day disciples. Surely we would not hesitate to answer just as Peter did, that Jesus is the Christ, Son of the living God.

But do our lives truly reflect this answer? If we really believe that Christ is the Son of God, sent to save us from our sins and lead us to Heaven, then we must say so, not just with words but with our actions. Do my ambitions and priorities in life say that Christ is my Savior and I am His disciple? Does my budget, my family life, my entertainment say so?

The gifts and blessings that God has given us — our time,



our talents, our material possessions — are meant to be used in a manner that says "Christ is my Savior and I am His disciple." The most eloquent praise we can offer Him is a life lived in grateful response to His unfathomable love. This is the beauty and power of a stewardship way of life.
