

Jesus said to the crowd, "Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life..." We can hardly blame the crowd for their shock at this statement - eating the Flesh and drinking the Blood of our Lord should cause us a bit of a

shock. Yet how easy it is to show up at Mass Sunday after Sunday, receiving the Eucharist as simply part of a weekly routine. If we really spent time contemplating the gift our Lord is offering us in this sacrament, we would be awestruck at the love and power in this gift. Through it, our Lord is giving us the very best He has to give — Himself. Not even the greatest theological scholar or the holiest of saints can fully understand this mystery. Thankfully we don't need to be a saint or a scholar to receive this gift. But we should do our best to receive the Eucharist with gratitude. And we can look to today's readings to glean two fundamental principles for becoming better Christian stewards. The Eucharist is the foundation for a stewardship way of life. DID YOU KNOW....

In 1946 <u>a second acquisition of</u> land expanded the property occupied by St. Mary's Church through a donation from the town of Holden. In 1906 the town had bought 4950 square feet of land along Princeton Street next to St. Mary's Church and built the Jefferson Hose House. It had a second floor where the firemen met. The town used the Hose House for less than forty years. At the town meeting of February 9, 1946 it was voted that " the Selectmen be authorized to convey to St. Mary's Church a parcel of land in Jefferson known as the Jefferson Hose House and agree on a price for the same." A few weeks later on February 26, 1946 Henry S. Muzzy, the town auditor, signed a statement saying: "Received a Daniel J. Harrington twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) covering the sale of the Jefferson Hosed House to St. Mary's Parish"
