Advent is a powerful season for preparation and reflection on the Incarnation of Jesus and His eventual return. It serves as a reminder of our individual judgment day and the importance of stewardship. The

The Gospel from Luke warns against distractions like indulgence and daily anxieties. #### DID YOU KNOW....

In 2007 there was an undertaking to build an addition to the church building. This addition included a multifunctional Gathering Room, a sacristy and two bathrooms. But as this renovation developed it was found necessary to also repair the church with vinyl siding and to repave the parking lot. The Lauring Construction Co. was the contractor for these projects. The estimated total cost of these three projects was \$736,240.00.

Next February the Gathering Room will be dedicated to the **Memory of Father Andy Remillard** and will be renamed **Father Andy's Room**.
