

JANUARY 5TH, 2025

Today is the Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord, celebrated on the Sunday between Jan. 2 and Jan. 8 in the U.S. "Epiphany" means "manifestation," marking the revelation of Jesus Christ as the light for all nations, shifting focus from the shepherds to the Magi, who symbolize the Gentiles. This day emphasizes the ongoing significance of Christmas and calls us to embody the Light of Christ in our lives. The poet William Cullen Bryant beautifully captures this senti-
