

DID YOU KNOW....

Ordinary Time is a period in the liturgical year of the Roman Rite that falls outside of the major seasons of Advent, Christmas, Lent, and Easter. It's a time to: Honor the mystery of Christ, Learn the teachings of Christ, Work to build up the Kingdom, Experience growth and maturation, and allow the mystery of Christ to penetrate history. Ordinary Time is marked by the color green, which symbolizes growth and new life. It's made up of two parts:

First part

It begins after the Epiphany and ends the day before Ash Wednesday.

Second Part

It begins on the Monday after the Pentecost and ends on the First Sunday of Advent
