## DID YOU KNOW....

Question: Why are priests now wearing green vestments? What does green symbolize?

**Answer:** The church is very "sensual" in that it wants to engage all of our senses. The different colors help us on our journey to Christ and our ultimate goal of heaven.

Green vestments are worn throughout the year during what is called "Ordinary Time." This includes most of the days throughout the year except for special feast days, Good Friday and the seasons of Advent, Christmas, Lent and Easter.

Green symbolizes life and hope, the life that we desire with Christ in heaven and the hope that God will give us the grace to attain it.
