DID YOU KNOW....

The Fisherman's Ring, also known as the Piscatory Ring, is a signet ring presented to the Pope at his inauguration. It symbolizes the Pope's authority as the successor of Saint Peter, the fisherman who was one of Jesus' first disciples. The ring's design traditionally features an image of St. Peter fishing from a boat, representing the Pope's connection to the Apostle Peter and the "rock" of the church. In the past, the Fisherman's Ring was used as a seal for the Pope's private letters and papal briefs.

Each new Pope receives a custom-designed Fisherman's Ring. After a Pope's death, the Fisherman's Ring is ceremonially destroyed by the Camerlengo (the head of the Church's financial administration), signifying the end of the deceased Pope's authority. The ring represents the unbroken spiritual lineage of the Papacy, connecting each Pope to St. Peter and his legacy.
