



Help provide evening meals to fellow St. Mary's parishioners in need. When a request arises, coordinator Kim Drozd emails volunteers with the details.


Pick a date, prepare a simple meal, and drop it off in a cooler at the recipient's door.

The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ — a feast that honors the incredible gift of the Eucharist. The Catechism calls the Eucharist the "source and summit of the Christian life" (CCC 1324), because it is

not just a symbol, but Christ Himself — His Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity.

The word Eucharist means "thanksgiving," reminding us to approach this gift with gratitude and reverence. As faithful stewards of God's blessings, we recognize the Eucharist as the greatest blessing of all.

In today's second reading, St. Paul recalls Jesus' words at the Last Supper: "This is my body that is for you." At every Mass, we witness that same self-giving love. Jesus offers Himself fully to us — humbly, completely, and out of love.

The Feast of Corpus Christi, also known as the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, is a significant celebration in the Catholic Church that honors the real presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist.

This feast serves as a reminder of the belief that during the Mass, the bread and wine become the actual Body and blood of Christ, a doctrine known as transubstantiation. It emphasizes the importance of the Eucharist in the life of the Church and faithful.
