

## 22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time

"Rather, when you hold a banquet, invite the poor, the crippled, the lame, the blind; blessed indeed will you be because of their inability to repay you." (Luke 14:13-14) One of the main

principles of living a stewardship lifestyle is to give without expecting anything in return. This is difficult for some to comprehend in our "consumerist" culture that we live in. This is even difficult for many parish communities that have become heavily dependent on parish fundraising events to support the mission and ministry of their local parish. Generally speaking, at a parish fundraiser, you pay money and receive something in return, it's just a financial transaction. This is opposed to our parish offertory at Holy Mass, where you unite your sacrifice with Jesus', renewing our covenant relationship with Him.

Rachel's Table is a volunteer-driven organization committed to fighting food waste and hunger throughout Greater Worcester. ## Did You Know

The act of genuflecting in front of the tabernacle is a sign of adoration and reverence for the presence of Jeus Christ, who is believed to be contained in the Blessed Sacrament. This gesture is rooted in ancient traditions and is a way to honor the real presence of God in the Eucharist. It is a physical expression of faith and humility, acknowledging the sanctity of the moment and the importance of the Blessed Sacrament. The practice is observed during Mass and outside of it, when passing before the tabernacle. It is a way to show respect and devotion to the Lord who is present in the tabernacle.
