




Mustard Seed Food Pantry-A Heartfelt Appeal



Did You Know

The priest puts a small amount of water into the wine at Mass to celebrate the Incarnation of Christ, where his divinity (wine) was united with his humanity (water). This act represents the faithful's union with Christ, as water and wine become inseparable, mirror how believers are joined with him in the Eucharist. The gesture also recalls the blood and water that flowed from Jesus' side on the cross, signifying the sacraments and our salvation.
