




Mission Statement

Truth shall spring out of the earth,

And justice shall look down from heaven...(Ps. 85)

Hello Everyone!

During the past four months, we have been honored to have five seminarians from Sacred Heart Major Seminary join us on campus, Wednesday evenings, to complete their Field-Ed credit. Unfortunately, as the semester comes to an end, so does their time with the OLR community.

These five seminarians (Josh, Peter, Matt, Mark, and Karl) embraced this program, and their time on campus, with such positivity and willingness to serve that it was truly inspiring. We started the semester going door to door, offering prayer for those in our surrounding community and to extend a personal invitation to visit OLR.

In four weeks, we were able to visit 52 homes, engage with 27 families, and pray with 15 of them right on their front porch! The highlight for me each week was hearing the stories from each team as they returned at the end of the night; it was obvious God was present.

As it started to get dark earlier, we transitioned over to the food pantry to assist with the new pick up hours. Inspired by Suzanne Barcewicz and our Christian Service Team, the seminarians were a friendly and welcoming face for our clients. They would greet the clients, help them with any administrative tasks, and guide them through the shopping process.

Once they had completed their shopping, the seminarians would offer to pray with each family. I know at this point in my life I shouldn't be shocked by what God can do, but I was amazed at the end of the first night when every family received prayer! It was beautiful and a perfect marriage between service and evangelization! Through this ministry, we have welcomed new families into our community and their children are in the process to receive the Sacraments. Thanks be to God!

Please keep these men in your prayers as they continue their discernment and education at Sacred Heart and continue to pray for vocations to the priesthood. God bless you all.


