


# OUR LADY OF REFUGE, Orchard Lake MI

Hello Everyone!

This week's gospel invites us to reflect on the profound encounter of John and Andrew when the said "Yes" to Jesus! As John the Baptist points to Jesus, proclaiming Him as the Lamb of God, John and Andrew follow Jesus.

This pivotal moment marks the beginning of their transformative journey with Jesus. In response to Jesus' question about what they seek, they express a profound desire to know Him better. Jesus, in turn, extends an invitation that transcends a physical location and calls them to abide with Him in a deeper, more spiritual sense.

As we reflect on this scripture, we are reminded how our own journey often begins with a simple "Yes" to a deeper and more profound encounter with Christ. Like Andrew and John, we are called to respond to the voice of the Lord and acknowledge His calling for each of us.

This Gospel passage challenges us to reflect on our own response to Jesus. Are we actively seeking to know Him more deeply? Are we putting ourselves in a position to hear His invitation through regular prayer and participation in the Sacraments? Are we saying "Yes" to God's calling for us? This passage is challenging us to respond to Christ's call to lead us into a more intimate relationship with Him. God bless!

### **Father Gerry Cupple**

Some of you might remember Fr. Gerry Cupple. As a seminarian, he was a fixture at Our Lady of Refuge in the late 70's helping with the Refuge youth groups: Yonge Street People and George Group. I met Gerry in 1975 when I was one of the night duty phone attendants at the rectory and he had just graduated from high school. Gerry and I became good friends through the Refuge youth group years. After he was ordained in 1985, we stayed in touch and did many weddings together. He baptized our daughter, Emily.

As the years flew by we lost touch, but we happened to reconnect last year for a lunch. Fr. Gerry was a great priest; he was very capable but humble. He did not care about recognition, but rather was more concerned about hearing how you were doing. He would rather serve than be served.

He was closing in on retirement and was excited to move to Hawaii. I am sorry he didn't make it there and that I didn't spend more time with him. It is a reminder to me to make that phone call rather than just think about making it. A vocation can be a solitary life - especially in retirement. If you know of a priest, brother or sister from years past, I can assure you they would be overjoyed to hear from you. To honor Fr. Gerry, there are a couple calls I am actually going to make instead of just thinking about it. Are there any priest or religious friends that would like to hear from you? You would honor Fr. 


