

As you might have seen or heard, registration is now open for religious education classes for the 24-25 school year. Classes are Monday evenings from 6-7:30, starting September 16 and continuing through May 19. All parish children in grades 1-8 are encouraged to attend, especially if they do not have religious education during their regular school day.

Sacrament prep for First Communion and Confirmation takes place during the religious education classes. This is different from the past when Confirmation prep classes took place on a different day. In order to make First Communion, children must have one year of previous religious education; so please send your first grade children! Confirmation is a 2-year program, starting in 7th grade and finishing with the ceremony in the spring of 8th grade. While these are the years when the sacraments are typically received, any children who have not received a sacrament may be part of the classes to prepare for it.

We're looking forward to a great year of learning and growing in the religious ed classes, with service projects in Advent and Lent, fun activities, songs, and bible passages.

I am still looking for volunteers to lead the classes: at least one regular catechist for middle school and a few on-call substitutes. Lessons will be provided to you, along with textbooks for the students. No teaching experience is necessary; all I ask is that you have a heart that loves and a desire to help children grow in their faith.

All new volunteers must complete a PGC session BEFORE commencing their ministry. 
