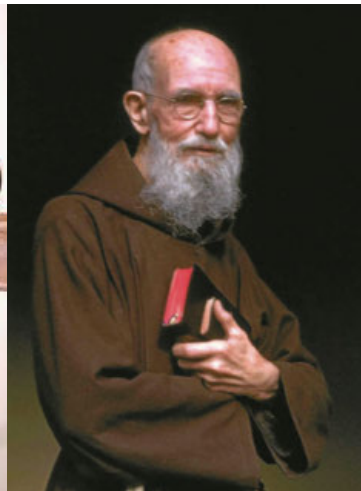
Join Us

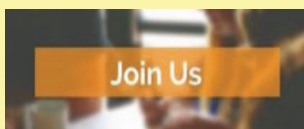
