The members of the Franciscan Missionaries of Hope are currently engaged in parish, hospital, and prison ministries.



Our Plight

As a young and growing congregation, the challenges which we face are numerous. However, the most immediate ones have to do with the formation and education of our student brothers. Like most religious congregations in Africa, we are blessed with vocation. Many young men express their interest in wanting to discern their vocation to religious life with us. Whereas we would like to admit all those who knock on our doors, we are restricted on the number we can admit because of our limited resources.



Your help is needed now!

In order to grow and realize the goal of serving the people of God in the Church and in the world, we have to keep admitting young men into our congregation. Equally important, we also have to ensure that those who have been admitted are given proper and requisite formation so that they can effectively serve in the Lord's vineyard. Currently, we have around forty student-brothers undergoing their seminary education and formation in various institutions.

In order to meet the rising costs of education so that we can provide quality formation so important to our brothers and to build Christian leadership in our Church, we need your help.

It costs two thousand dollars to send one brother to school for a year. Your gift of any amount will go a long way in helping in the formation of our brothers.



The number of shoppers at our pantry has grown significantly. Last year, we averaged 42 shoppers per month. In August alone, we've already served 73 shoppers, including 27 just last week.


