Twenty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time

We might call this Sunday “Power Sunday” because the main theme of all three readings is that God is the Source of all authority. God shares His authority with civil rulers elected to serve the people and with the Pope and the other Church leaders for the material and spiritual welfare of His children. Today’s Gospel challenges us to accept the authority of Jesus as our Lord and Savior as St. Peter did at Caesarea Philippi.

The first reading, taken from Isaiah, tells us how God hates unfaithful and selfish officials. He removed the proud “master of the royal palace” from his office, taking from Shebna the power and responsibility of which he had proven unworthy, and gave both to the humble and faithful Eliakim. The robe, the sash, and the keys were the insignia of this office. In today’s Responsorial Psalm (Ps 138), David thanks God for having raised him from lowly origins and given him authority as king over the people of Israel. In the second reading, St. Paul praises God for the depth of His wisdom, knowledge, and correct judgment, asserting that He is the Source of all authority on earth and in Heaven. Today’s Gospel passage shows us how Peter confessed Jesus as his Lord and Savior and how Jesus, in turn, approved Peter’s words and gave him teaching and ruling authority in Jesus’ Church. Thus, Jesus establishes a “Magisterium” to serve the spiritual and physical needs of the Church members. His statement, “I will give you the Keys of the Kingdom of Heaven,” gives Peter and his successors the power to bind and to loose (make laws; exercise authority) in the Church, with assurance that their decisions would be ratified in Heaven.

Life messages: 1) We need to accept and experience Jesus as our Lord and personal Savior: First, we should accept Jesus as the Son of God and our personal Savior. This means that we are accepting Jesus as our Good Shepherd, our Divine Savior, and our Redeemer. Second, Jesus should become a living experience for us – as our God protecting us and providing for us in our life’s journey, loving us, forgiving us, helping us, and transforming our lives and outlook. We receive these gifts by listening to Jesus through the daily, meditative reading of the Bible, by talking to Jesus through daily, personal, communal and liturgical prayers, by offering our lives on the altar with Jesus whenever we participate in the Holy Mass, by receiving Jesus in Holy Communion, and by leading exemplary lives, as we cooperate with God’s grace. Our personal experience of Jesus will also lead us to praise and thank God in all the events of our lives, both pleasant, and painful, realizing that God’s loving hands are behind everything.

2) We need to surrender our lives to Jesus, our Lord and Savior. That surrender requires that we freely give all areas of our lives to Jesus and radiate to all around us Jesus’ sacrificial agápe love, unconditional forgiveness, overflowing mercy, and committed service. The joy, the love, and the peace that we find in Jesus need to be reflected in the way we live our whole lives. We also surrender our lives to Jesus by rendering loving, humble service to others with the strong conviction that Jesus is present in every person. (Fr. Tony’s Homilies)

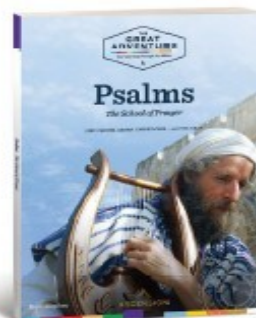

THE ROCK OF OUR FAITH

"Who do you say that I am?" Jesus poses this vital question to His disciples in today's Gospel, leading to Peter's bold declaration of faith: "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." Upon this rock of faith, Christ promises to build His Church, entrusting Peter with the keys to the kingdom. Today's liturgy invites each of us to answer Jesus' question for ourselves—recognizing Him as our Lord, offering Him our highest praise, and allowing His power to transform how we live in the world.



MUSIC LINEUP

Opening: Christ in Me Arise (#834)

We open our worship with an urgent, personal prayer asking the Lord to awaken His presence within us. As we sing, we invite Christ to open our eyes, heal our hearts, and dispel our darkness so that, like Peter, we can clearly see and proclaim Jesus as our Savior.

Offertory: God, We Praise You (#682)

As we bring our gifts to the altar, we turn our hearts toward majestic praise of the Holy Trinity, lifting our voices to acknowledge God's eternal authority, creator power, and endless mercy as we offer our lives back to Him.

Communion: I Am the Bread of Life (#1008) & Many and Great (#1024)

Approaching the altar, "I Am the Bread of Life" centers us on Christ's core promise: those who eat His flesh and drink His blood will live forever. We follow with "Many and Great," celebrating how the one Eucharistic meal unites us as the one body of Christ, many members drawn together into a single, holy communion.

Closing: Holy God, We Praise Thy Name (#662)

We conclude our liturgy with a grand, timeless hymn of adoration. Proclaiming "infinite Thy vast domain, everlasting is Thy reign," we go forth into the world boldly declaring our faith in the King of Kings who has built His Church on an unshakable foundation.

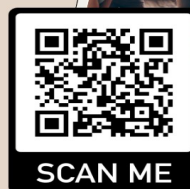

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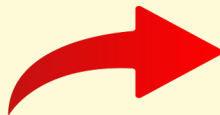
