

Tell Congress to pass the SAVE OUR VETERANS'S LIVES Act of 2025 (HR.1987 - S.926)

"From 2003 to 2022, more than **87,000** veterans died by gun suicide. Every single day, 13 veterans die by gun suicide... The bipartisan *Saving Our Veterans' Lives Act* would require the VA to offer gun lock boxes and secure storage information to veterans who request them. Tell the EAC you OPPOSE Proof of Citizenship for voter registration

(A law firm) "has petitioned the Election Assistance Commission (EAC) to require proof of citizenship when registering to vote, (though federal courts blocked a similar provision in the president's March executive order on elections.) Such a requirement would impose expensive burdens on a vast number of Americans, including the 47% of citizens who don't have a passport, the millions of married women whose names no longer match their birth certificates, and everyone who has moved and needs to request an original birth certificate from the state where they were born."

"Submit a comment: On the <u>Federal Register</u> (click the green box labeled "Submit a comment") opposing the new rule <u>before October 20</u>. Use your own words (copy/paste content is rejected) to submit a unique comment about why this issue matters to you. 
VOLUNTEERS NEEDED for the new 40-bed emergency overnight shelter (112 S. Humphrey)

- **Dinner Providers** Prepare hot dinner meal for 40 to be dropped off by 7:00 PM. Dinner providers can also volunteer for evening hosting if they want to stay and serve.
- **Breakfast Providers** Donate breakfast supplies for 40 (cereal, fruit, juice, yogurt, etc.).
- **Lunch Providers** Donate bagged lunches for 40 (sandwiches, chips, fruit, cookies, etc.) for guests to take with them when leaving the shelter the next day.
- Evening Hosting 6:00 PM to 10:00 PM (shift can be split) Interact with guests, set up, and clean up.
- Morning Hosting 6:00 AM to 8:00 AM Assist with breakfast and clean-up.

- EV Charger Credit: Looking to install a home charger? Get up to \$1,000 back on your taxes until June 30,
 2026.
- Residential Clean Energy Credits: Claim 30% of the total cost of solar panels, battery storage, and geothermal systems if you **buy by December 31, 2025**.
- Energy Efficient Home Upgrade Credits: Make home energy upgrades, like insulation, windows, or efficient electric appliances, by **December 31, 2025** to claim the credit.
