

"The Department of the Interior has proposed an **83% cut** to Tribal college funding... Treaty rights negotiated with the federal government require funding of at least \$40,000 per student. But instead of closing the \$250 million funding gap that already exists, Congress is poised to widen it, catastrophically. SC-SL Rectory Shelter **housing**

The Neighborhood Bridge is launching a volunteer-staffed Essentials Pantry in the former rectory at St. Catherine-St. Lucy in mid-August.

The Neighborhood Bridge, born out of the Renew My Church initiative, is dedicated to connecting Austin families with the services they need to thrive. Families from our 5 partner schools in Austin will be able to receive household necessities, such as cleaning supplies, toiletries, and baby products. Volunteers are needed to receive, stock, and deliver items to the schools. The commitment is fewer than 4 hours per week. Housing Forward is scheduled to open a new emergency overnight shelter with 40 beds in September at 112 S. Humphrey Avenue in Oak Park. This is twice as many beds as were available at the Saint Catherine of Siena-Saint Lucy Ministry Center. This means additional volunteer opportunities to not only provide meals, but serve and interact with guests, similar to the prior PADS model, but without the distraction of traveling locations!

Volunteers are a key to the success of the emergency shelter. Between the emergency overnight shelter and the Interim Housing Program, **we provide 1,260 meals every week!** Individuals and groups are welcome to be part of creating a safe and stable place for individuals and families experiencing homelessness.

Update as of August 14, 2025: "World Central Kitchen founder Chef José Andrés is visiting Gaza and Israel this week to advocate for a dramatic increase in humanitarian aid to Palestinians to avert starvation, the release of all Israeli hostages, and an end to the war.

WCK has served more than <u>145 million meals in Gaza</u> and more than <u>two million in Israel</u> since the start of the war. Gaza meal production is currently about 200,000 daily, but <u>cooking has been greatly reduced</u> this year as food supplies have been halted or constrained.

<u>Food reclamation volunteer needed for 4th Monday and 4th Friday of each month</u>--What is food reclamation? It's when volunteers go to a designated store to claim food that is no longer sellable,

but still perfectly edible. This commitment is once a month for a full year. In less than 24 hours spread over a year, you could save tons of food from landfills and get it to our neighbors in need.

What are the requirements?

- Food pick-up must be done between 11am-1pm
- Be able to lift boxes weighing up to 30 pounds.
- Have a larger vehicle (minivan, SUV, station wagon).

LAST CALL for Energy Efficiency/Clean Energy Tax Credits

Recent legislation has cut short the timeline of federal energy efficiency and renewable energy tax credits. Improving energy efficiency and electrification reduces carbon pollution, while also saving money on bills.

Homes: Available tax credits include up to \$3,200 per year for qualified improvements on your home until Dec. 31st, 2025. The credit is 30% of certain qualified expenses for certain energy efficient appliances and weatherizing your home: including \$150 for home energy audits; \$250 for an exterior door (\$500 total for all exterior doors); \$600 for exterior windows and skylights; central air conditioners; electric panels and certain related equipment; \$2,000 for select highly efficient electric heat pump water heaters and electric heat pumps.

Vehicles: The federal tax credit for new and used EVs ends after **Sept. 30, 2025**. To claim up to \$7,500 for a new EV or \$4,000 for a used vehicle, you must purchase and take delivery before the deadline. Eligibility rules still apply and income limits remain in

Home energy: The credit is worth 30% of the cost to install qualifying systems that use solar, wind, geothermal, biomass, or fuel cell power to produce electricity until Dec. 31st, 2025.

(Evidently, *major insurance companies* think climate change is "real"...)

"For 40 days this summer, Illinois atmospheric scientist Victor Gensini and roughly 100 other specialists and students traveled the Great Plains to investigate severe the storms that cause tornadoes and thunderheads. They learned climate change seems to be altering the hailstones themselves. A warmer atmosphere, research from Gensini and others published last year in Nature suggests, can make hail bigger, heavier and more damaging to homeowners than some hurricanes and wildfires.

The severe storms resulted in \$60 billion in losses in 2024, according to the Insurance Information Institute, and insurers blamed **hail** as one reason for recent hikes to homeowners' insurance rates in Illinois. State Farm announced last month it's raising rates for more than 1.5 million homeowners in Illinois by an average of more than 27% beginning tomorrow. That rate hike followed another made by Allstate, which increased Illinois home insurance rates about 14 percent beginning in February. [WBEZ/Inside Climate News]"
