Covenant Agreement for AYM Mission Trip

This is a big commitment and we realize you have many other things going on in your life. However, once you are selected to be part of this mission trip, the entire crew for your trip needs you to be committed to all meetings and planned functions. Your spot on the team may be forfeited, without refund, if any of the below items are not followed:

- Attendance at Meeting and Events: It is vital that you participate in and attend the meetings. Be responsible. While there are many things to balance in life, this is one thing you are choosing to balance in your schedule. As such, once you are selected as part of this team, absences are undesirable. Why? Absences affect everyone your entire crew. They need you present as part of the formation for all of you as a group. Emergencies are understood but must be communicated. Meeting schedule is All at 7:00 in the Pine Room
- **Financial responsibility**: The trip is completely self-funded, meaning all money comes from the people going on the trip and the fund-raisers run specifically for the trip. Each trip is budgeted according to the specific number of teens and adults per each crew/van (5 teens and 2 adults). The total cost for ASP 2026 has been estimated at \$950 - \$1,000 per teen. This includes ASP registration fee, ASP t-shirt, gas, van rental, supplies while on the trip, and other incidentals related to managing ASP. In 2025 each teen earned an average of over \$250 thru fundraising. There is no guarantee that we will raise the same amount for this year. Also, this cost may change depending on gas prices, van rental, and other factors.

FOR ASP applicants, you/your family is responsible for the following payment schedule:

- \$200 deposit with registration paperwork. After acceptance, deposit is nonrefundable.
- \$200 payment by Feb 1, 2026
- Your specific final balance by July 1, 2026
- **Fundraisers:** Full participation in any work crew fundraiser is a choice for which you will be rewarded. Money raised in large group fundraisers (i.e. car washes) will be split evenly among all who participated in the fundraising. If you raise more than your required amount, we will consider the excess as a donation to this year's trip. Whatever monies not raised to cover your fee is YOUR responsibility.

DROPPING OUT: Every year teens sign up for ASP and exit at various times through the year. While there may be a waitlist created, know that every drop, at any time, places the ASP team in a very difficult position.

If, for some reason, you need to back out of the trip and we have participants on a waitlist to take your spot, the reconciliation of the balance and fundraising earned will be a conversation between the The ASP Planning Committee and the teen/family from the waitlist coming to take the spot. In most case fundraising amounts earned from the original participant will go to the person taking their spot. The deposit is always forfeited.

If you back out of the trip, at any time and the waitlist has been exhausted and there is no teen to take your child's

place, the balance of the trip is STILL the responsibility of the family who planned to go.
