Keep the pressure on Congress: DEFUND ICE (At issue: ending warrantless arrests; protections for schools, churches, and hospitals; mandating ICE officers unmask; and independent investigations into ICE abuses.)



Tell Congress: Don't silence dissent with tear gas

"If tear gas is too dangerous for a battlefield, there is no justification for using it against people in our cities. I urge you to introduce and pass legislation to ban the domestic use of tear gas."

Tear gas is a chemical weapon **BANNED in warfare** by both the Chemical Weapons Convention and Geneva Protocol. But these agreements allowed for a critical, dangerous exception: **Use by domestic law enforcement.**

Tell Target: ICE OUT NOW

1. Demand ICE must leave Minnesota now.

2. Any officer who kills a civilian must be held legally accountable. That starts with legitimate investigations and charges by local officials.
3. Exercise the company's 4th Amendment rights and publicly post signage denying entrance to on-duty immigration agents who do not have signed judicial warrants as required by law, as well train staff on how to respond when immigration agents arrive at stores.
4. Demand: NO additional federal funding for ICE in the upcoming Congressional budget, and ICE should be investigated for human and Constitutional violations of Americans and our neighbors.
5. Restore company commitment to Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion and honor their commitments to the Black community.



Oppose the Federal Concealed Carry Mandate (H.R. 38 and S.65)

*States have the power to decide who is too dangerous to carry a concealed weapon in public and where concealed firearms cannot be carried... H.R. 38 and S. 65 would create a federal mandate that would **override state gun laws**, forcing every state to recognize every other state's concealed carry standards—including those with weak or no standards at all. This legislation would **make it easier for people with dangerous histories—like those convicted of violent crimes, domestic abusers, and stalkers—to carry a concealed and loaded gun in public in states that wouldn't otherwise let them.***

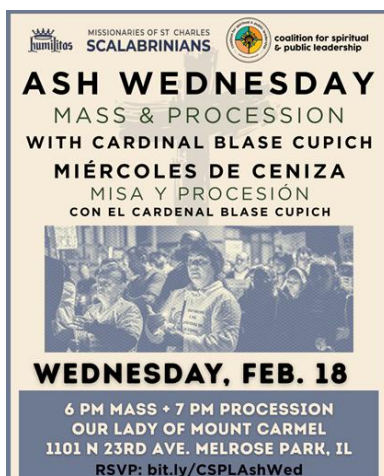

VOTE!! 267 days until the mid-term elections

General **Primary** Election: March 17, 2026

February 5, 2026: First day to vote early or by mail.

February 17, 2026: Last day for regular (paper) voter registration.

February 18, 2026: First day of grace period for in-person voter registration and voting at election authority and early voting sites; continues through Election Day.

March 1, 2026: Last day for online voter registration. Grace period registration is still available at election authority and early voting sites.

March 12, 2026: Last day for election authority to receive vote by mail applications.

March 17, 2026: Primary Election Day! Polls are open from 6:00 am to 7:00 pm.
