Happy New Year!

No, I'm not confused - it's the First Sunday of Advent, which means we begin a new liturgical year. The Church, unlike the world, doesn't wait for fireworks and party hats. We begin our new year not with champagne, but with candles, prayer, and - let's be honest - probably some leftover turkey from Thanksgiving!

Now, Advent is a beautiful and meaningful season. The word "Advent" comes from the Latin *adventus*, meaning "coming" or "arrival." It's a time when we prepare our hearts for the coming of Christ; first, as a baby in Bethlehem, and second, for His return in glory at the end of time. So yes, it's both about Christmas past and heavenly future and in between those two comings, it's about Christ coming to us now, in our daily lives.

Jesus tells us in today's Gospel from Matthew, "Stay awake, for you do not know on which day your Lord will come." That doesn't mean you shouldn't take naps, it means be spiritually awake! Be ready! Because when God shows up, we don't want to be too busy checking our phones or finishing leftovers to notice Him.

You see, Advent is not just about putting up decorations or making a gift list - though I'm sure Amazon already knows what you want. It's about preparing the inn of our hearts so that when Jesus comes, He doesn't find a "No Vacancy" sign. Let's get rid of bitterness, hatred, jealousy, selfishness, envy etc - so that there's room for joy, peace, and love.

Just four days ago, many of us gathered around a table loaded with food, turkey, mashed potatoes, gravy, and maybe for Filipinos like me some adobo and lumpia. Thanksgiving is about gratitude and that's exactly where Advent begins. Because when we're grateful for what God has already given us, we become more ready to receive what He's about to give us through that baby in the manger.

Think of this, Thanksgiving fills our stomachs, but Advent fills our souls. Thanksgiving reminds us to be thankful for what we have; Advent reminds us to be hopeful for what's coming. Both are about opening our hearts - to God and to one another.

So as we light the first purple candle on the Advent wreath - the candle of Hope - let's remember that this season is not meant to rush us, but to ready us. It's a time to slow down, to pray, to forgive, to look for Christ not only in the manger; but in our neighbor, our family, our community.

The Gospel of St. Matthew – Cycle A



As we begin this new liturgical year, our Sunday readings are from the Gospel of St. Matthew. In the second century A.D., the Gospel of Matthew was placed at the very beginning of the New Testament. It was believed to be the first Gospel written, though we now know that the Gospel of Mark dates earlier. Because it is the Gospel most intensely concerned with issues related to Judaism, it provides an appropriate transition from the Old Testament to the New Testament in the Christian Bible. Matthew became the most important of all Gospel texts for first- and second-century Christians because it contains all the elements important to the early church: the story about Jesus's miraculous conception; an explanation of the importance of liturgy, law, discipleship, and teaching; and an account of Jesus's life and death. The Gospel of Matthew has long been considered the most important of the four Gospels.

Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception Holy Day of Obligation



On Monday, December 8, the Church invites all Catholics to gather to celebrate the Eucharist in praise of the goodness of God who preserved Mary, the Mother of Jesus, from Original Sin at the first moment of her conception.
