# THE SANCTUARY YOUTH SERIES

In today's Gospel we hear Jesus tell his disciples to "Go and tell John what you hear and see: the blind regain their sight, the lame walk, lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the poor have the good news proclaimed to them."

We know not all who were blind could see again, Lazarus died again and yet we know God is still with us through it all. He settles our ways, directs us and while we may not receive the miracle we hope for, he guides us all on our own journeys to him.

Our parish has been blessed that our Mental Health Ministry presented the Sanctuary for Catholic program for adults which many of our parishioners attend. Recently the Sanctuary folks created a new series designed for youth due to the urgent need. We have already shown films such as LIKE to Anxious Nation that focused on the challenges our youth face, sometimes on a daily basis, but now we are grateful to be able to share with you the faith-based Sanctuary Youth Series starting on January 8 for eight Thursday nights through March.

This series is designed to raise awareness and reduce stigma by starting conversations about mental health in youth ministry settings. By the end of this series, young people will have:

- Increased their mental health literacy;
- Reduced social and self stigma surrounding mental illnesses;
- Learned how to care for their own mental health;
- Developed positive attitudes towards help-seeking;
- Cultivated a greater understanding of God and explored what it looks like to follow God in seasons of flourishing and languishing mental health; and
- Engaged in spiritual practices of companionship.

Sanctuary Youth Series is for young people with questions about mental health and mental health challenges; living with mental health challenges; supporting family and friends with mental health challenges; leaders who want to engage their students in conversations about mental health, mental health challenges, and faith; and parents who would like to join will be welcome to join a separate, parallel session with any adult leaders. Our target demographic is youth ages eleven to fifteen years old, but can go up to those in their senior year.

Our youth will gather for this series in our Teen Center while any parents & teachers can join the parent/adult group up in the hall. We met with our youth, walked through a session at Intersection and Edge and I learned that while they all have a knowledge of the term mental health, they have not had a chance to dive into it or look at it through our faith foundation.

The more we talk about mental health, the more we are ready to walk through any upcoming challenges we may have and understand others. Truly, these are tools we all want our children to have as they grow and mature. "Rejoice: The Lord is nigh." As Christmas draws near, the Church emphasizes the joy which should be in our hearts over all that the birth of our Savior means for us. The great joy of Christians is to see the day drawing nigh when the Lord will come again in His glory to lead them into His kingdom. The oft-repeated Veni ("Come") of Advent is an echo not only of the prophets but also of the conclusion of the Apocalypse of St. John: "Come, Lord Jesus," the last words of the New Testament. The Third Sunday of Advent is known as Gaudete Sunday. The term Gaudete refers to the first word of the Entrance Antiphon, "Rejoice." Rose vestments are worn to emphasize our joy that Christmas is near, and we also light the rose candle on our Advent wreath.



## Happy Anniversary 83 Years – St. Nicholas Church

"The St. Nicholas story begins at St. Joseph's in Mountain View. Founded in 1901, St. Joseph's parish encompassed an immense area including Palo Alto, Sunnyvale, and Los Altos." In the spring of 1940, Catholic women of Los Altos organized the Los Altos Catholic Women's Club to raise money for a church. Their initiative stirred the interest of all Catholic in the community. Frank Marini and his sisters purchased the preferred site and offered it to Archdiocese of San Francisco in February of 1941. On Sunday morning, December 20, 1942, Archbishop John J. Mitty blessed and dedicated the Church of St. Nicholas. We give thanks and praise to God this coming Friday, December 20 for 83 years of celebrating our faith as One, Holy, Catholic, and Apostolic Church.
