

From the desk of Fr. Bart:

During our Masses this weekend, we celebrate the Most Holy Body and Blood of our Savior, Jesus Christ. It's an opportunity for us to reflect on the Eucharist, which is the source and summit of the Christian life. The term "Eucharist" comes from the Greek word eucharistia, which translates as thanksgiving. From the USCCB:

In the celebration of the Eucharist, bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ through the power of the Holy Spirit and the instrumentality of the priest. The whole Christ is truly present -body, blood, soul, and divinity -- under the appearances of bread and wine, the glorified Christ who rose from the dead. This is what the Church means when she speaks of the "Real Presence" of Christ in the Eucharist.

By eating the Body and drinking the Blood of Christ in the Eucharist, we become united to the person of Christ through his humanity. "Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him" (Jn 6:56). In being united to the humanity of Christ, we are at the same time united to his divinity. Our mortal and corruptible natures are transformed by being joined to the source of life.



We must always remember to give thanks for the salvation which we have received through Christ's sacrifice, and strive to live in a way that reflects our gratitude for this unearned, eternal gift.

Additionally, this weekend we are celebrating an important historic step in our journey to become Queen of Martyrs Parish. We welcome Bishop Donald Hying, as he presides over our Sunday morning Mass, and officially installs me as your pastor. It's very humbling to lead these four Churches as they become one prayerful and faithful mission-oriented entity. Each of our church parishes offer unique, strong traditions, adding richness to our newly merged parish. Combining our resources and congregations to form a single, unified Church will allow us to better serve our community, giving us greater opportunities to introduce people to the love of Jesus and make disciples.

Through the intercession of Mary, Queen of Martyrs, let us go forth in joy, giving witness to Christ and building up His Church.


Queen of Martyrs Parish: Building Our Future Together!


