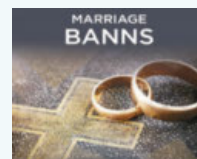

Hearts Full of Hope: Campaign Update

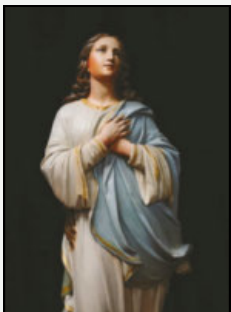

The Assumption of Mary: Our Blessed Hope!

Friday August 15th is the **Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary**, a Holy Day of Obligation. (See page 5 for our mass schedule.) We celebrate the Catholic belief that at the end of her earthly life, Mary was taken up body and soul into heavenly glory. The Assumption reminds us of our own destiny: where she has gone, we hope to follow. Mary, the first and most faithful disciple, is a sign of sure hope and comfort for the pilgrim Church. She stands as our Mother, constantly interceding for us, and showing us how to say “yes” to God.

It is a beautiful providence that the **Our Lady of the Assumption Church and School in Beloit** bears the name of this powerful mystery of our faith. While the exact reason for its naming might be found in the parish's early founding records, the title itself reflects the Church's deep trust in Mary as Queen of Heaven and Mother of the Church. The Dance Studio has a wonderful history here in our community working with children and families. They will be occupying the Middle School portion of the building and will have special privilege for use of the gymnasium for tumbling and baton twirling. Since losing our partnership with Beloit Public School Even Start Program in 2024, we have been in search of a new tenant that we could share the space with. We will still be able to hold our Parish Wednesday Night Catechesis Religious Education Program, Tuesday morning Mommy and Me Play Group, and Spanish Language Catholic Retreats in the building. This will be a great source of income for our parish and allows us to continue to use the space as well.

Please keep our OLA School Teachers in your prayers this week as they make their annual retreat to prepare spiritually for the new School Year. Let us pray that their

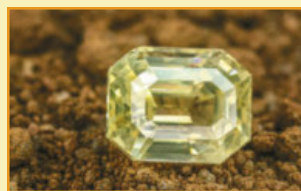

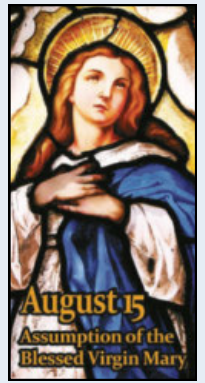
