

### 19th Sunday of Ordinary Time- Be Ready, Lamps Lit!

In this Sunday's Gospel (Luke 12:35–40), Jesus urges His disciples to be like servants waiting for their master's return—alert, faithful, and prepared. "Gird your loins and light your lamps," He says. The message is simple but urgent: live today as if Christ were coming tonight. When our hearts are rooted in Him, we don't fear the unknown—we live with purpose, peace, and a joyful hope in His return. The Christian life is not passive. It is watchful love in action!

## The Assumption of Mary: Our Blessed Hope!

Friday August 15th is the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, a Holy Day of Obligation. (See page 5 for our mass schedule.) We celebrate the Catholic belief that at the end of her earthly life, Mary was taken up body and soul into heavenly glory. The Assumption reminds us of our own destiny: where she has gone, we hope to follow. Mary, the first and most faithful disciple, is a sign of sure hope and comfort for the pilgrim Church. She stands as our Mother, constantly interceding for us, and showing us how to say "yes" to God.

It is a beautiful providence that the **Our Lady of the Assumption Church and School in Beloit** bears the name of this powerful mystery of our faith. While the exact reason for its naming might be found in the parish's early founding records, the title itself reflects the Church's deep trust in Mary as Queen of Heaven and Mother of the Church. This will be a great source of income for our parish and allows us to continue to use the space as well.
