From the Desk of Fr. Bart

Queen of Martyrs Parish Feast Day

This weekend, we celebrate our very first parish feast day since the canonical merger of our four parishes into *Queen of Martyrs Parish* this past June. By liturgical law, a parish is permitted to transfer its titular feast day to the Sunday Masses of Ordinary Time so that the whole community may celebrate together. Our feast is the *Memorial of Our Lady of Sorrows* (September 15), which we keep in place of the usual *Exaltation of the Holy Cross* this year. Our Lady of Sorrows is a fitting patroness for *Queen of Martyrs*, because she stood faithfully at the foot of the Cross, sharing in Christ's sufferings and uniting her heart to the sacrifice of her Son. Our parish name also embraces the heritage of our founding communities—St. Thomas, St. Jude, and St. Stephen—three martyrs of the Church, now gathered under the loving protection of Mary, especially honored here as both Our Lady of Sorrows and Our Lady of the Assumption. This feast day is a sign of unity, identity, and mission for our newly formed parish family.

Queen of Martyrs Parish Festival

We joyfully welcome everyone to our first *Queen of Martyrs Parish Festival*! A heartfelt thank-you to the planning committee, our many volunteers, generous sponsors, and all of you who are participating in this special event. May this celebration strengthen our bonds of friendship, build up our parish community, and help raise much-needed funds for our mission. May God bless this day with joy, fellowship, and success!

Hearts Full of Hope Capital Campaign

We continue to be grateful for the generosity of our parishioners who have supported our *Hearts Full of Hope Capital Campaign*. Please see the progress report at the bottom of the page. Major work on the church is now complete—the new roof, fresh window trim painting, ramp, and air conditioning are all finished. We also thank José Rivera and the volunteers who repainted the yellow parking lot lines. The final piece of the project will be the renovation of the convent bathrooms, which will allow us to welcome the Sisters of the Eucharistic Heart of Jesus into our parish home.

Merger Update

The next step in our merger is the Civil Merger. We are working on the paperwork with the state of Wisconsin. Our papers were delivered to the Rock County Courthouse on Monday, August 25, 2025. Being registered with the state, we will be issued our new FEIN number, which is a tax-exempt number. When this is given, we will be civilly merged. The final step will be a financial merger, as we move our assets into the First National Bank under Queen of Martyrs Parish. The financial merger will take a few months, but we hope we will be financially merged early in 2026. We, of course, will respect the donor intent and keep our designated funds for each church, while combining our Sunday offertory income into the same checking account. The budget for this current fiscal year is becoming more solid, and we will have a more accurate final annual budget as a merged parish to present to parishioners. We also hope to have last year's Annual Finance Reports ready to be published by the end of this month. As you probably know from reading the bulletin, last fiscal year was not positive. There was a deficit, which we are trying to eliminate for this year and for moving forward, so we can have a budget that is sustainable, even given the decline in our weekly collections. Thanks again for your generosity, and I hope to get these reports out soon.




