Twenty-Sixth Sunday of Ordinary Time

In today's Gospel, Jesus tells the parable of the rich man and Lazarus. The rich man lived in comfort while Lazarus, poor and suffering, lay at his gate unnoticed. When both died, their fates were reversed—the rich man found himself in torment, while Lazarus rested in Abraham's bosom. The message is clear: indifference to the suffering of others has eternal consequences. We are called to see Christ in the poor, the marginalized, and the forgotten. True discipleship means crossing the gap now, with compassion and generosity, so that no chasm separates us from God's love. This week, let us open our eyes and hearts to those in need around us.

September is celebrated in the Catholic Church as Hispanic Ministry Month, a time to honor the gifts, faith, and traditions of our Hispanic brothers and sisters. The U.S. Bishops remind us in their pastoral letter *Strangers No Longer: Together on the Journey of Hope* that the Church is enriched when cultures come together in unity and diversity. Here at Queen of Martyrs Parish, we are blessed with a vibrant Hispanic Ministry. Presbyteral Assembly 2025

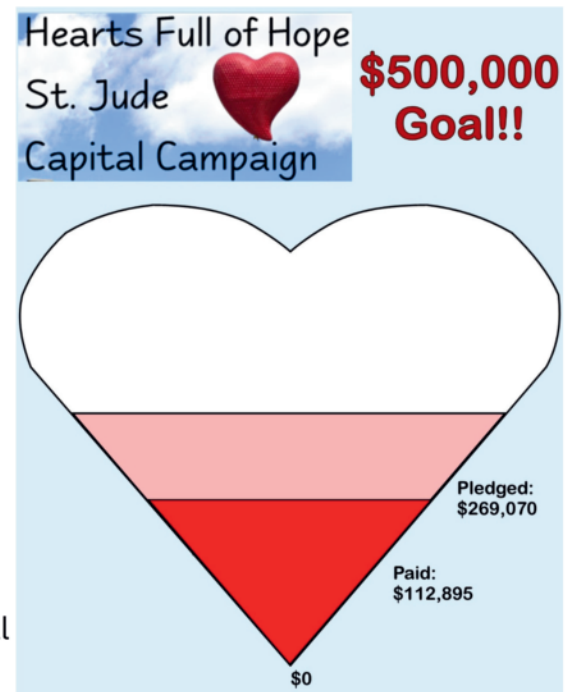

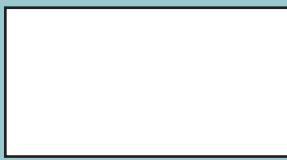
