New Musical Element at Mass Beginning in Advent



Beginning this Advent, Queen of Martyrs Parish will include a new musical element in our weekend liturgies: the Entrance Antiphon and the Communion Antiphon. The Antiphons are short scriptural verses traditionally assigned to each Mass in the liturgical calendar. They serve as a prayerful reflection that connects directly to the themes of the day's readings and the season. Though these have always been part of the Church's liturgical texts, they have not been a regular part of our parish music tradition.

At Queen of Martyrs, the Entrance Antiphon will be sung before the Opening Hymn, and the Communion Antiphon will be sung immediately after the priest receives Holy Communion. These will be performed by the cantor, accompanied by the accompanist. The congregation will participate through silent prayer and reflection as the Antiphons are sung on their behalf.

This addition enriches our worship by deepening the connection between Scripture and song, and by helping us enter more prayerfully into each part of the Mass.

Thank you for embracing this beautiful enhancement to our liturgy as we begin the new Church year in Advent.

Advent Mass Setting: The Chant Mass

As we enter the holy season of Advent, we will once again be using the Chant Mass setting for our weekend liturgies. This is the same musical setting we used during Lent earlier this year. Its simple, prayerful melodies beautifully reflect the spirit of Advent – a time of quiet anticipation and preparation for the coming of Christ.

You'll hear the Chant Mass used for the Kyrie, Holy, Holy, Holy, Mystery of Faith, the Lord's Prayer, and the Angus Dei. As is customary, the Gloria will not be sung during Advent but will return with joy at Christmas, when we resume the Mass of St. Ann setting.

May this season's music help us all enter more deeply into prayer as we prepare our hearts for the birth of Christ.


St. Stephen has been asked to assist the Clinton Community Outreach Program's Christmas Food Drive by collecting jars of





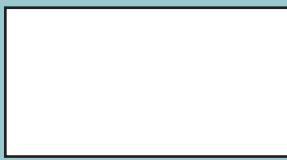
