From the Desk of Fr. Bart

Third Sunday of Advent, Gaudete Sunday

Today the Church celebrates Gaudete Sunday—“Rejoice!”—a burst of joy right in the middle of Advent. We light the rose-colored candle and wear rose vestments as a sign that the Lord is near and our waiting is filled with hope. In today’s Gospel (Matthew 11:2–11), Jesus reminds John the Baptist that the signs of the Kingdom are already unfolding: the blind see, the lame walk, the poor hear Good News. Even in our struggles and worries, God is at work. The rose candle tells us: Don’t lose heart—Christ is closer than you think. Let this be a week of renewed joy, deeper faith, and confident trust in the One who comes to save us.

A Welcoming Church at Christmas

Christmas is one of the most grace-filled moments of the year—when many who are searching, hurting, unsure, or long-absent take a chance and come to Mass. Let’s be the kind of parish that welcomes them with warmth and joy. A friendly smile, a simple greeting, helping someone find a seat, or giving up your favorite spot can make all the difference. Consider parking farther away so guests can use the closer spaces. As disciple makers, I want to remind ourselves that “belonging precedes believing”—our kindness can open hearts to Jesus. Please invite your family, friends, co-workers, and neighbors to join us for Mass this Christmas. A personal invitation is one of the most powerful ways to share our faith.

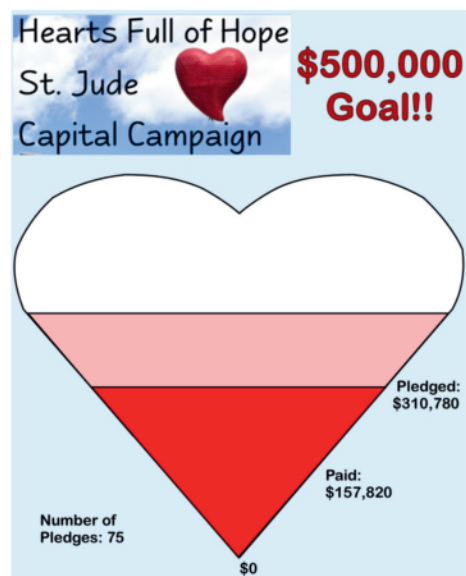
A Holy, Grace-filled Christmas

New Musical Element at Mass in Advent

During Advent, our weekend liturgies will include an Entrance Antiphon and the Communion Antiphon.

They are short scriptural verses traditionally assigned to each Mass in the liturgical calendar. They serve as a prayerful reflection that connects directly to the themes of the readings and season. Though these have always been part of the Church's liturgical texts, they have not been a regular part of our parish music tradition.

At Queen of Martyrs, the Entrance Antiphon will be sung before the Opening Hymn, and the Communion Antiphon will be sung immediately after the priest receives Holy Communion. These will be performed by the cantor, accompanied by the accompanist. The congregation will participate through silent prayer and reflection as the Antiphons are sung on their behalf.

This addition enriches our worship by deepening the connection between Scripture and song, and by helping us enter more prayerfully into each part of the Mass.

Advent Mass Setting: The Chant Mass

As we enter the holy season of Advent, we will once again be using the Chant Mass setting for our weekend liturgies. You'll hear the Chant Mass used for the Kyrie, Holy, Holy, Holy, Mystery of Faith, the Lord's Prayer, and the Angus Dei.

As is customary, the Gloria will not be sung during Advent but will return with joy at Christmas, when we resume the Mass of St. Ann setting.

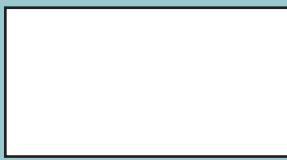
