## From the Desk of Fr. Bart

### Third Sunday of Ordinary Time – Word of God Sunday

This Sunday's Gospel (Matthew 4:12–23) marks a decisive turning point in Jesus' ministry. Having heard of John the Baptist's arrest, Jesus withdraws to Galilee—not in fear, but in fulfillment of God's plan. Matthew tells us that Jesus settles in Capernaum, “in the region of Zebulun and Naphtali,” fulfilling Isaiah's prophecy: “The people who sit in darkness have seen a great light.” From this moment forward, Jesus begins to proclaim the heart of His message: “**Repent, for the Kingdom of heaven is at hand.**” Repentance is not merely turning away from sin, but turning toward a Person—Jesus Himself—who calls us out of darkness and into the light of new life. Immediately, He calls ordinary fishermen to follow Him, reminding us that God's Word is living and active, calling each of us today.

Today we also celebrate **Word of God Sunday**, instituted by **Pope Francis** to deepen our love for Sacred Scripture and our reverence for God who speaks to His people. The Word of God is not simply a book—it is God's living voice, proclaimed in the Church and fulfilled in Jesus Christ. Every Catholic is invited to encounter Scripture regularly, prayerfully, and within the life of the Church. As Catholics, we read the Bible **with the Church**, guided by Tradition and the Holy Spirit. Some key principles for Catholic biblical interpretation include:

- Scripture must be read **in unity with the whole Bible**, not in isolation
- Scripture is interpreted **within the living Tradition of the Church**
- The ultimate purpose of Scripture is **our salvation and conversion**

May Word of God Sunday renew in us a hunger for the Scriptures and a deeper desire to follow Christ more faithfully.

Catholic Schools Week invites us to give thanks for the gift of Catholic education and to recommit ourselves to forming young people as disciples of Jesus Christ. As communities of faith, Catholic schools help students recognize their true destiny—to become saints. All are invited to join us for the 10:30 a.m. Mass at OLA this Sunday as we give thanks for Catholic schools and for the many benefactors who make Catholic education possible.

St. Blaise was a physician who later became a priest and eventually Bishop of Sebaste in Armenia. During a time of persecution, he lived as a hermit in the hills until he was arrested by Roman authorities. While imprisoned, he miraculously healed a young boy who was choking on a fish bone. In gratitude, the boy's mother brought Blaise food and candles while he awaited martyrdom. This miracle gave rise to the Church's devotion to St. Blaise as a powerful intercessor for illnesses of the throat—a devotion that continues in the Church to this day. Through his prayers, may we be strengthened in faith and health, and may our voices always proclaim the goodness of God.

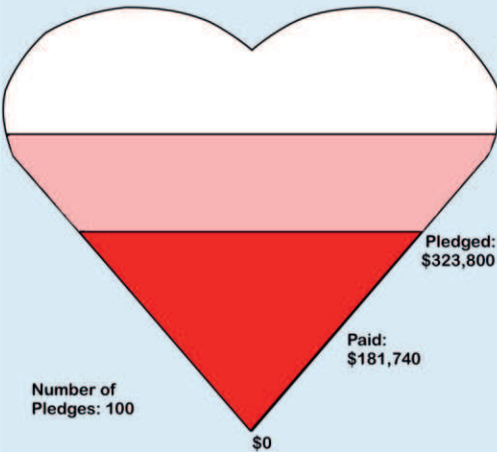

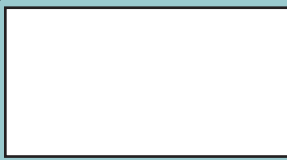
