From the Desk of Fr. Bart

Fourth Sunday of Ordinary Time

This Sunday we hear one of the most beloved—and most challenging—passages in all of Scripture: **the Beatitudes** from the Sermon on the Mount. At first glance, Jesus' words can surprise us.

Blessed are the poor... the meek... those who mourn... the persecuted. These are not the people the world usually calls “successful.” So why does Jesus call them blessed? Because Jesus is not describing a list of rewards for suffering. He is revealing **what life looks like when** it is rooted in God. The Beatitudes describe people who have learned to depend on God rather than themselves, to hunger for righteousness more than comfort, to show mercy because they know their own need for mercy. These are people whose hearts are open—open to God, open to others, open to grace. They are “blessed” not because their lives are easy, but because **God is close to them.**

In the Beatitudes, Jesus is not giving us an impossible ideal; He is offering us a new way to live. This week, we might ask ourselves: *Which Beatitude speaks most to my life right now?*

The Presentation of the Lord & the World Day for Consecrated Life

On February 2, the Church celebrates the **Presentation of the Lord**, often called **Candlemas Day**. Forty days after Christmas, Mary and Joseph bring the infant Jesus to the Temple, where He is recognized by Simeon as “*a light for revelation to the nations.*” For this reason, candles are blessed on this day, reminding us that **Christ is the Light of the world.**

This beautiful feast is also the **World Day for Consecrated Life**, a day when the Church gives thanks for those who have consecrated their lives entirely to God. Consecrated life takes many forms and through prayer, service, teaching, and witness, they remind the Church—and the world—that God alone is enough.

We are especially grateful for the religious sisters who minister among us at Queen of Martyrs Parish, including the **Sisters of the Eucharistic Heart of Jesus**, the **Auxiliaries of the Blessed Sacrament**, and the **Franciscans**. Their presence, prayer, and joyful witness are a tremendous gift to our parish and school communities.

On Candlemas Day, we thank God for the light they bring to the Church—and we pray that many hearts will be inspired to listen for God's call in their own lives.

12:00 p.m. at St. Thomas with a special blessing for our sisters.

6:30 p.m. at St. Jude (Spanish) with Candle Procession.

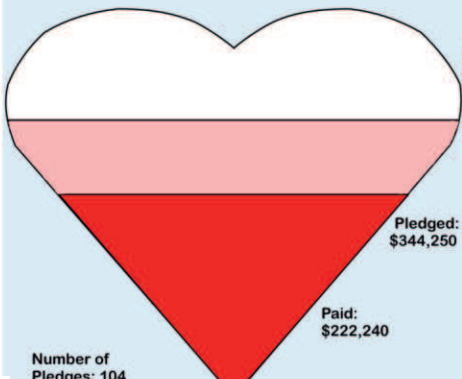
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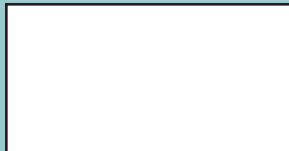
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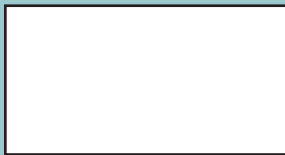
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
