From the Desk of Fr. Bart

First Sunday of Lent – Into the Desert with Jesus (Matthew 4:1-11)

At the very beginning of His public ministry, Jesus is led into the desert—not to escape life, but to face it honestly. There He is tempted with comfort, power, and shortcuts. “Turn stones into bread.” “Prove Yourself.” “Take control.” These are the same voices we still hear today: *Choose what’s easy. Put yourself first. Avoid the cross.*

But Jesus responds with Scripture, prayer, and trust in the Father. He shows us that true freedom does not come from having more, but from belonging more deeply to God. Lent is our desert with Jesus—a sacred time to strip away distractions and remember who we are and whom we serve. What temptation is Jesus inviting you to face honestly this Lent—and how will you choose Him instead?

“This Lent, let’s Encounter Jesus... and let Him change everything.”

Lent is not about doing more for God—it is about making room for God to do more in us. Through prayer, Scripture, repentance, and service, we open our hearts to real conversion. The Lord says to us: **“Return to me with all your heart.” (Joel 2:12)**

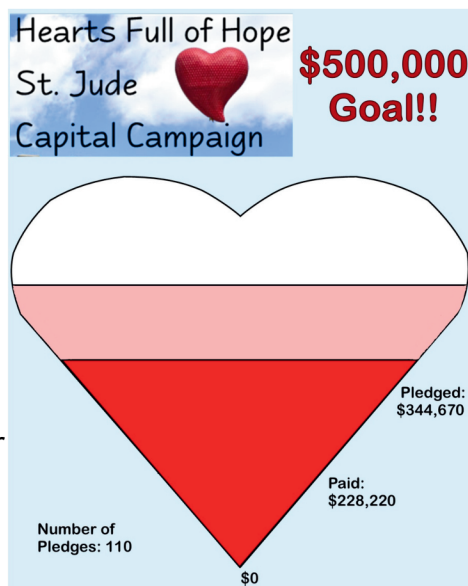

As of February 9, 2026, MAID is legal in 13 U.S. states and D.C., as well as in countries such as Austria, Canada, and Finland. In the United States, these laws are often called “Death with Dignity” laws, a term first used by Oregon when it legalized MAID in 1997; its statute has served as a model for many others.

Major medical organizations, including the American Medical Association, the American College of Physicians, and the World Medical Association, officially oppose MAID. The AMA says it conflicts with the physician’s role as healer and poses societal risks, while the American College of Physicians emphasizes compassionate communication, high-quality care, and hospice as better alternatives. Their stance reflects the principles of the Hippocratic Oath, attributed to Hippocrates, which calls on doctors to “do no harm.” However, at least 10 AMA state chapters, mostly where MAID is legal, have dropped their opposition.

Fasting and Abstinence During Lent



Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.

St. (Pope) John Paul II once described Lent as a “commitment to a new life, inspired by Gospel values,” moving away from selfishness and drawing closer to the path Christ.

That path, according to Pope John Paul II, can be summarized in the words of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving, with fasting consisting of moderation in food and lifestyle as “a sincere effort to remove from our hearts all that is the result of sin and inclines us to evil.”

For members of our Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

Children, adults with physical or mental illness, as well as pregnant women and those nursing, are all exempt from fasting. The USCCB stresses that “common sense should prevail” and that no one should jeopardize their health to fast.

If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday night) as the “paschal fast” to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily his Resurrection.

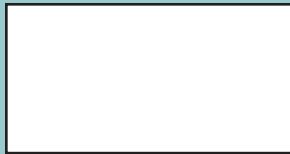
