

PARISH DATA - With the spirit and intention of better knowing our parish families and individuals to serve you better we have been cleaning up our parish census. This process also practically reduces mailing costs. We have maintained information but

We are aware of most of our elder parishioners who are homebound and understandably unable to financially support us.

Pastoral Planning for Our Parishes and Schools

On May 15, Bishop Koenig published his pastoral year to introduce United in Christ, Pastoral Planning for our Parishes and Schools. You can read the letter at this link:

To help us understand this synodal process, we will include some information in the bulletin to offer catechesis in church concepts and will continue to tell you about developments.

Our deanery includes the most mission or connected churches of any of the deaneries. Mission churches are those who are not parishes on their own but are connected to another parish church and pastor. Our mission churches are: St. Rose of Lima, St. Jude, St. Teresa and St. Agnes. Resurrection is now connected to Holy Family sharing a pastor. St. John the Baptist on Main St in Newark was the original parish church for the parish we know as St. John/Holy Angels. So, there are 8 pastors and 14 church buildings. Our deanery also has 4 associate pastors.

Next week you will hear about some opportunities to participate in offering your feedback for this process.






